Boats headed all directions west and east, many over the bramble bank, also Mike ventured after to Castle Pointl.

Dogfish, Bull Huss, Bream, Pout, Whiting, smooth hound and rays. were caught

First place was Mike with Dogfish, An undulate ray of 9.5 lb, pouting and whiting, with 139 points; Second place was Lee with Bull Huss, Dogfish and Whiting with 132 points; third was Paul A with a Dogfish and Smooth hound giving 98 points; forth was Brian with a Bream, Dogfish and Pouting giving 95 points;; joint fifth was Dave A and Les both with a Dogfish and Pouting, giving 72 points. Joint sixth was Shaun, Paul H, Bob, Phil and Clive with a dogfish giving 47 points. Notable fish caught was Mike with a 10lb conger and Les with a 25lb conger and 2lb Pouting. Non club members; Steve Shaun's friend also caught a whiting and dogfish; Lees friend caught Dogfish.

The next competition will be a Whiting competition on Sunday 8th December .
